Coinbase also performs additional compliance checks for security and regulatory purposes, which can slow down the timeline depending on the user's region. During this period, users may be able to access limited features but cannot complete certain actions like large withdrawals or higher-value trades. One useful tip to speed up the process is submitting documents using the Coinbase mobile app, which can capture clearer, higher-quality images compared to manual uploads.
